SUGGESTED BOOKS FOR PLAYING PRESCHOOL

Each unit in Playing Preschool suggests (typically) six books to be used in conjunction with the lessons. <u>These books are a suggestion</u>. Feel free to add more or use other titles you can find at home, borrowing from friends, or in the library.

HOW TO PRINT THE PROGRAM

If you are interested in printing out Playing Preschool, you have my full permission to do so. You are licensed to print one single copy. When printing Playing Preschool Year 1, please choose the file PLAYING PRESCHOOL YEAR 1. You will also need to print the ALPHABET PAGES YEAR 1 separately.

To minimize printing costs, here are some quick tips:

- Print in black and white
- Choose double sided
- Pick the lightest weight paper possible

To bind it, I chose to coil bind my personal copies and have a color cover added to the front. You can also have the program hole punched into a 3-ring binder.

Online print shops (that will print and ship to you) are far less expensive than traditional print shops. If you are printing from a "big box" printing company, make sure to first check online for any printing promo codes.
